



## HEALTH & SAFETY GENERAL POLICY STATEMENT

At Olympus Global we recognise our duties under the Health and Safety at Work etc Act 1974 and associated regulations. We will endeavour to meet the requirements of this legislation and maintain a safe and healthy working environment. Our Managers, Supervisors and Employees are informed of their responsibilities to ensure they all take reasonable precautions to ensure the safety, health and welfare of those that are likely to be affected by the operation of our business, being amongst others our customers, contractors, visitors, the public and any others who come into contact with the work activities of the Company.

Olympus Global recognises its duty, so far as is reasonably practicable:

- to make regular assessment of the hazards and risks created in the course of our business
- to provide adequate control of the health & safety risks so identified;
- to consult with our employees on matters of health & safety;
- to provide and maintain safe plant and equipment;
- to ensure the safe handling and use of substances;
- to provide information, instruction and training where necessary to our workforce;
- to ensure that all workers are competent to do their work and to give them the appropriate training to prevent accidents and cases of work related ill health;
- to maintain safe and health working conditions;
- to actively manage and supervise health & safety at work;
- to have access to competent advice;
- to review annually and revise as necessary, this policy;
- to provide adequate resources for its implementation; and
- to provide the resource to give this policy effect

We also recognise

- our duty to co-operate and work with other employers when we work at premises or sites under their control to ensure the continued health and safety of all those at work, and
- our duty to co-operate and work with other employers and their workers, when their workers come to our premises or sites to do work for us, to ensure the health and safety of everyone at work.




Olympus Global is the corporate body upon which the duties of the Health & Safety at Work Act 1974 are placed, these duties will be implemented through our Managing Directors' who will ensure sufficient resources are in place to allow the Company to maintain, plan, monitor and where necessary improve safety performance.

To help achieve our objectives and ensure our employees recognise their duties under health & safety legislation whilst at work, we also inform them of their duty to take reasonable care for themselves and others who might be affected by their activities. We achieve this by explaining their duty and setting out our company health and safety rules in an Employee Safety Handbook, which is made available to every worker employed by us.

In support of this policy a responsibility chart and more detailed arrangements have been prepared.

The policy will be reviewed biennially and more often should the business change in any way or as determined by changes in legislation. Any revision necessary to improve safety performance will be made and then reported to our employees. Revisions and changes to this policy and its supporting documentation will only be authorised and approved under control.
